ORDINANCE 86 - 30

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps from RH to BL/PCD and Grant Outline Plan Approval RE: Southwest Corner of Kingston and Longview (All American Family Storage Park)

WHEREAS,

the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS,

the Plan Commission has considered this case, BL/PCD-31-86 and recommended that the petitioner, All American Family Storage Park, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petitinon for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT;

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RH to BL/PCD for property located at the Southwest corner of Kingston and Longview and more accurately described as follows:

A part of the Southwest quarter of Section 35, Township 9 North Range 1 West, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 35; thence West 903.71 feet; thence North 652.00 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing North 292.93 feet to the south right-of-way of Longview Avenue; thence east along said south right-of-way 267.29 feet to the west right-of-way of Kingston Place; thence south along said west right-of-way 292.93 feet; thence West 270.00 feet to the point of beginning containing 1.79 acres more or less.

SECTION II. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline plan be approved and that the above designated property be designated a Planned Unit Development.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
