

ORDINANCE 86-51

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF
TITLE 15 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE
PERTAINING TO MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS AND
GARAGES AND LIMITED PARKING ZONES

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington is strongly committed to revitalization of the downtown; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington wishes to provide a greater inducement to revitalization of the downtown area by creating greater flexibility for parking:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana that:

SECTION 1. Section 15.40.010 of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to add the following:

(9) Walnut Street Parking Garage: located at the southwest corner of Walnut and Fourth Streets, on lots 34, 35, 36 and the north one half of lot 33 in the original plat of the City of Bloomington.

SECTION 2. Section 15.40.020(a) of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

The charge for the use of the Walnut Street Parking Garage shall be ten cents per thirty minute period or part thereof, and twenty cents per sixty minutes for the use of each space between the hours of seven a.m. and seven p.m. everyday except Sundays. The charge shall be collected by parking meters, or attendants. The charge for the use of municipal parking lots 1 and 3 shall be ten cents per thirty minute period or part thereof, and twenty cents per sixty minutes for the use of each space between the hours of eight a.m. and five p.m., everyday except Sundays. The charge shall be collected by parking meters.

The charge for the use of all other municipal parking lots and the Register Center Parking Garage shall be five cents per thirty minute period or part thereof, and ten cents per sixty minutes for the use of each space between the hours of eight a.m. and five p.m., everyday except Sundays. The charge shall be collected by parking meters.

SECTION 3. Section 15.40.020 of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to add the following:

(c) Any vehicle exiting the Walnut Street Parking Garage without a parking receipt issued upon entrance shall be required to pay a lost receipt fee of two dollars and fifty cents per day.

(d) The Board of Public Works is authorized to alter or modify the hourly charge or method of payment for parking in any and/or all municipal parking lots and garages in conjunction with special events and/or promotional activities.

SECTION 4. Section 15.40.030(a) and (b) of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

15.40.030 - Parking Permits

(a) The City will issue four types of annual parking permits.

- (1) A limited number of annual parking leases, hereinafter referred to as Class A permits (not to exceed 25% of the available spaces for specific spaces on the lower level of the Regester Center Parking Garage are available. A limited number of annual parking leases, hereinafter referred to as Class A-W permits (not to exceed 25% of the available spaces) for specific spaces in the Walnut Street Parking Garage are available. A limited number of annual parking leases, hereinafter referred to as Class A-2 permits (not to exceed 35% of the available spaces) for specific spaces in Lot 2 are available. And, a limited number of annual parking leases, hereinafter referred to as Class A-5 permits (not to exceed 25% of the available spaces) for specific spaces in Lot 5 are available. The charge for such annual parking leases in the Regester Center Parking Garage and the Walnut Street Parking Garage shall be Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) per year, payable in advance. The charge for such annual parking leases in Lots 2 and 5 shall be Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per year, payable in advance.

In addition, unlimited duplicate Class A, Class A-W, Class A-2, and Class A-5 permits shall be available to Class A, Class A-W, Class A-2 and Class A-5 permit holders, respectively at Five Dollars (\$5.00) per permit; each duplicate permit shall allow the permit holder to park an additional designated vehicle in the original Class A, Class A-W, Class A-2, or Class A-5 permit holder's specific designated stall only. No duplicate Class A, Class A-W, Class A-2, or Class A-5 permit-bearing vehicle may park in any other space or in any other lot, without proper permit for such lot. Only motor vehicles displaying a Class A, Class A-W, Class A-2, or Class A-5 permit or duplicate permit for that stall may park in a leased stall. Violators shall be ticketed and may be towed.

The Board of Public Works shall determine the location of annual leased parking spaces and the method of allocation of all annual permits.

- (2) Parking privileges, hereafter referred to as Class B permits, shall be made available for parking on a rental basis in any of the City parking lots and garages, and in available spaces excluding those designated for Class A, Class A-W, Class A-2, Class A-5, Class M and Class M-W permits in Municipal parking lots. The charge for such privilege shall be One Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$170.00) per year, payable in advance, or Forty Five Dollars (\$45.00) per three month quarter, or Seventeen Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$17.50) per month, payable in advance.

Monthly permits will be available January 1, 1987.

(b) The City will issue two types of monthly parking permits:

- (1) A limited number of monthly parking leases, hereafter referred to as Class M permits (not to exceed 100 parking spaces) for specific spaces in the Regester Center Parking Garage are available. In addition, a limited number of monthly parking leases, hereafter referred to as Class M-W permits (not to exceed 85 parking spaces) for specific spaces in the Walnut Street Parking Garage are available.

The charge for such spaces shall be Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) per month, payable in advance. In addition, unlimited duplicate Class M and Class M-W permits shall be available to a Class M or Class M-W permit holder at One Dollar (\$1.00) per permit; each duplicate permit shall allow the permit holder to park an additional designated vehicle in the original Class M or Class M-W permit holder's specific designated stall only. No duplicate Class M or Class M-W permit-bearing vehicle may park in any other space or in any other lot, without proper permit for such lot. Only motor vehicles displaying a Class M or Class M-W permit or duplicate permit for that stall may park in a leased stall. Any car illegally parked in a leased stall shall be ticketed and may be towed.

The Board of Public Works shall determine the location and number of monthly permits to be made available, and the method of allocation.

- (2) The holder of a Class M and Class M-W permit may renew his permit on a monthly basis. The Class M and Class M-W permit holder shall be given the first option to purchase a monthly lease for the same specific space for the subsequent month, provided that he purchases the Class M or Class M-W permit after the first, but prior to the twentieth day of the preceding month. If the Class M or Class M-W permit holder has not exercised his option by the twentieth day of the month, the specific space may be leased to any individual who pays the Thirty Dollar (\$30.00) fee.

SECTION 5. Section 15.40.010(8) and Section 15.40.050 shall be amended to substitute the name Regester Center Parking Garage for the name Municipal Parking Garage.

SECTION 6. Section 15.32.090 of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

15.32.090 - Limited parking zones.

- (a) The streets or parts of streets described in Schedule N, attached hereto and made a part hereof, are designated limited parking zones. When appropriate signs are erected no person shall park a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts of streets for a period of time longer than the maximum limit designated in the schedule.
- (b) No person shall park a vehicle within the same one hundred block of any street during any calendar day after the maximum time limit contained in Schedule N has expired during the hours that the restrictions on parking are in effect.

SECTION 7. The pertinent part of Section 15.32.090, Schedule N, shall be amended to read as follows:


Legend:

- (1) 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. except Sunday.
- (2) 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. except Sunday.
- (3) 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- (4) 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. except Sunday.
- (5) 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. except Sunday.
- (6) Any Time.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect commencing November 1, 1986.







SYNOPSIS

This Ordinance adds the Walnut Street Parking Garage as a municipal parking garage; establishes the hourly fee for parking at twenty cents for the Walnut Street Parking Garage, and the municipal parking lots located at Fourth and Dunn and Fourth and Washington; establishes the hourly fee for parking in all other municipal lots and garages at ten cents per hour; establishes a lost receipt fee for the Walnut Street Parking Garage of two dollars and fifty cents per day; creates annual parking leases in the Walnut Street Parking Garage (not to exceed 25% of the available spaces); increases the number of annual parking spaces in Lot 2 to 35% of the available spaces; increases the cost of annual parking permits to \$250.00 or \$300.00, depending upon location; increases the cost of monthly parking permits to \$30.00; places additional restrictions upon parking in limited parking zones; and officially changes the name of the Municipal Parking Garage to the Register Center Parking Garage.
