## ORDINANCE 86 - 60 To Amend the Zoning Maps from RL to ML 1901 S. Rogers (LeeJon Diversified)

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and the new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission as considered this case, ZO-68-86, and recommended that the petitioner, LeeJon Diversified, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RL to ML for property located at 1901 S. Rogers, and more particularly described as follows:

A part of the northeast quarter of Section 8, Township 8 North Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, described as follows: beginning at a point that is 1,177.72 feet north and 775.50 feet west of the southeast corner of the said quarter, said point being in the centerline of South Rogers Street, thence north 86 degrees 55 minutes 30 seconds east for a distance of 564.90 feet and to the west right-of-way line of the Illinois Central Railroad, thence north 26 degrees 16 minutes 45 seconds west 219.72 feet over and along the west right-of-way of said Illinois Central Railroad; thence continuing over and along said right-of-way North 28 degrees 53 minutes 00 seconds WEst 107.00 feet; thence north 89 degrees 52 minutes 48 seconds west 409.07 feet and to the center line of South Rogers Street, thence south 01 degree 02 minutes 00 seconds east 341.96 feet and to the point of beginning.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
