ORDINANCE 86-64

<u>To Amend Title 9 of the</u> <u>Bloomington Municipal Code, Entitled "Water"</u>

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 9.08.010 <u>Monthly rates generally.</u> of Chapter 9.08 of Title 9 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, shall be amended to read as follows:

<u>9.08.010 Monthly rates generally.</u> The following rates and charges are established for the use of and service rendered by the water utility of the city:

SECTION II. Section 9.08.020 <u>Contract sales for resale</u> of Chapter 9.08 of Title 9 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, shall be amended to read as follows: <u>9.08.020</u> Contract sales for resale. The rates for contract sales for resale shall be seventy cents per one thousand gallons.

SECTION IV. Section 9.12.030 <u>Service installation charge.</u> of Chapter 9.12 of Title 9 of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

<u>9.12.030 Service installation charge.</u> (a) The charge for service installation within the city that requires tapping a distribution main and installing tubing and a meter shall be two hunired eighty-five dollars. The charge for service installation within the city that requires only that tubing and a meter be installed shall be two hundred seventeen dollars.

(b) The charge for service installation outside the city that requires tapping a distribution main and installing tubing and a meter shall be three hundred forty-five dollars.

SECTION V. Customer billing shall be computed with these rates for the first full billing cycle following final approval by the Public Service Commission.

SECTION VI. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
