WHEREAS, the Community Economic Development Division of the Indiana Department of Commerce has developed an Indiana Main Street Program for Indiana communities, and


WHEREAS, the program offers communities technical assistance in implementing its own Main Street Program at the local level, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington is implementing downtown revitalization by both private and public efforts,



SECTION 1. Consent is hereby given for the City of Bloomington acting through the Redevelopment Department to apply for participation in the Indiana Main Street Program.


