

RESOLUTION 86-12

A resolution of the Common Council of the City of Bloomington expressing support for the overall improvement, widening, or four-laning of Indiana State Road 37 from Bedford, Indiana, south to Interstate Highway 64.


WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana recognizes the importance of a modern state highway system and the promotion of safety, economic development, tourism and quality of life in the community; and
