## ORDINANCE 85-8

To Amend the Comprehensive Plan as It Relates to Land Use in the Area Bounded by S.R. 37 Bypass, the Griffy Creek Floodplain, Cascade Park Golf Course, and Bloomington High School North. (North Corridor)

WHEREAS, the Bloomington Plan Commission has considered and recommended that the Bloomington Master Plan be changed;
