

ORDINANCE 85 - 10

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps from RS to PUD
And Grant Outline Approval for the PUD
RE: East Covenanter Drive South of the Present Eton Mews

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, PUD-77-84, and recommended that the petitioner, BENCHMARK ATLANTIC, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and requests that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RS to PUD for property located on East Covenanter Drive, and more accurately described as follows:

Part of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 2, Township 8 North, Range 1 West in Monroe County, Indiana, described as follows:

Begin a 6 inch square wooden fence post at the northwest corner of said quarter quarter; thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East on the north line of said quarter quarter and along an existing fence 1072.60 feet to an existing 5/8 inch rebar with a yellow cap at the southeast corner of an 11.56 acre tract of land described in an instrument recorded in deed record 304, page 260 in the office of the recorder of said county; thence South 02 degrees 11 minutes 30 seconds East along the southward extension of the east line of said 11.56 acre tract 488.83 feet to a 5/8" rebar; thence South 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 1073.80 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar set on the west line of said quarter quarter; thence North 2 degrees 03 minutes 02 seconds West on said west line 488.80 feet to the point of beginning, containing 12.03 acres, more or less, subject to all legal easements and right-of-ways.

SECTION II. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline plan be approved and that the above described parcels be designated a planned unit development.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
