

Ordinance 85-14

To Transfer Appropriations Within the Parks and Recreation General Fund

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, that:

SECTION I. The Controller may adjust the appropriations of the following budget, to-wit:

PARKS AND RECREATION FUND

From: Line #234 Repair/Maintenance Supplies \$1,344.00
Line #351 Contractual Services--Electrical \$3,640.00
To: Line # 43 Improvements other than Building \$4,984.00

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval by the Mayor.

SYNOPSIS

This budget transfer will provide a portion of the funds needed to purchase a metal-halide lighting system for Lower Cascades Softball Complex. The balance of funds necessary will be provided by transfer of funds from the Parks and Recreation Non-Reverting Operating Fund for a total amount of \$7527.00, as provided in Appropriation Ordinance 85-2.
