

ORDINANCE 85 - 19

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps from RL to ML/PCD
And Grant Outline Approval for the PCD
RE: Nathan Silverstein - 1700 Block S. Henderson

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ML/PCD-26-85, and recommended that the petitioner, NATHAN SILVERSTEIN, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and requests that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RL to ML/PCD for property located at the 1700 Block of South Henderson, and more accurately described as follows:

A part of the Northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 9, Township 8 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, described as follows: Beginning at a point that is 26.09 feet N1250'W and 15.00 feet S88239'W of the Southeast corner of said quarter-quarter, said point being the intersection of the North line of Miller Drive and the West line of Henderson Street in Bloomington, Indiana, thence N1250'W over and along the West line of Henderson Street for a distance of 352.82 feet, thence S82200'W for a distance of 760.15 feet, thence S1245'E for a distance of 264.76 feet to the North line of Miller Drive, thence N88239'E over and along the said North line of Miller Drive for a distance of 756.14 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 5.36 acres, more or less. Subject to all easements and rights of way of record.

SECTION II. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline plan be approved and that the above described parcel be designated a planned commercial development.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
