A Resolution Recommending the Establishment of a Campus-Community Bicycle Task Force

WHEREAS, Issues of bicycle safety and security are of concern to a growing number in the Bloomington and Indiana University communities; and

WHEREAS, information has been gathered regarding the ways in which other university communities and their police agencies handle bicycle safety, security and recreation; and

WHEREAS, A continuing cooperative effort between the City and the University on issues of bicycle safety and security is of mutual benefit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

The Common Council of the City of Bloomington hereby recommends that a campus-community bicycle task force, composed of twelve members be appointed with three members appointed by the Common Council, three by the Mayor, and six by Indiana University administration; that the members should represent Indiana University administration, faculty and students, the City, recreational bicycling associations, police departments, and planning departments of the City and County;

The Council further recommends that the duties of the Task Force include the following: defining areas of concern, including bicycle registration, security of bicycle racks and safety issues; proposing solutions for recommendation to the appropriate City and/or University agencies or bodies; and designing and disseminating public information and education on bicycle safety, security and recreation.

SYNOPSIS
