

RESOLUTION 85-40

RESOLUTION OF THE BLOOMINGTON COMMON COUNCIL APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE PARKING FACILITY TO BE LOCATED AT FOURTH AND WALNUT STREETS IN BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, On June 5, 1985, the Bloomington Common Council determined that the City of Bloomington is in need of a parking facility; and

WHEREAS, The Bloomington Downtown Parking Development Corporation was incorporated for the purpose of building a parking facility; and

WHEREAS, The Bloomington Downtown Parking Development Corporation created the Design Review Committee; and

WHEREAS, The Bloomington Downtown Parking Development Corporation and the Design Review Committee have considered and approved plans and specifications for the parking facility; and

WHEREAS, The Bloomington Board of Public Works has considered and approved plans and specifications for the parking facility; and

WHEREAS, The plans and specifications have been submitted to the Bloomington Common Council for its consideration.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, that:

1. The plans and specifications for the parking facility to be located at Fourth and Walnut Streets, as prepared by Clair K. Wolverton, have been reviewed by the Common Council, and are hereby approved.
2. The Common Council hereby encourages and urges the Bloomington Downtown Parking Development Corporation to continue and proceed in its effort to construct a parking facility to be located on Fourth and Walnut Streets.
3. Severability. If any section, sentence or provision of this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other parts of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid part, and to this end the provisions of this resolution are declared to be severable.
