ORDINANCE 84 - 2

To Vacate a Public Parcel

WHEREAS, IC 36-7-3-12 authorizes the Common Council to vacate public ways and places upon petition of persons who own or are interested in lots contiguous to those public ways and places; and

WHEREAS. the petitioner, CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, has filed a petition to vacate a parcel of City property in the University Park area; and

IC 36-7-3-512 requires the Plan Commission to make a recommendation WHEREAS, on the proposed vacation and to forward it to the Common Council; and

WHEREAS,

the Plan Commission has considered this petition and made a favorable recommendation on its adoption;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-3-12, a portion of City-owned property in the University Park area shall be vacated. The property is more particularly described as follows:

Public rights-of-way in an area bounded by and the north right-of-way of East Fourteenth Street, the west right-of-way of North Woodlawn Avenue, the south right-of-way of Seventeenth Street and the east right-of-way of North Fess Avenue.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council, approval by the Mayor, and published according to law.
