ORDINANCE 84 -17

To Amend Chapter 20.08.03.00 and 20.08.04.00 of Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code

WHEREAS, the Bloomington Plan Commission has considered and recommended that the Bloomington Municipal Code be changed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 20.08.04.00, <u>Special conditions for bulk, density, height,</u> area, and aesthetic requirements, sub-sections (8) and (9) be amended to read as follows:

(8) No minimum required for units in existing building space other than main floors; 1000 square feet of lot area per unit required for new construction of more than one unit.

(9) No sideyard required by commercial uses or for residential use of existing building space. Any residential portions of any new building must be set back at least six feet from the side lot line but in no case closer than twenty feet from any adjacent building wall.

SECTION II. Section 20.08.04.00, <u>Special conditions for bulk, density, height, area, and aesthetic requirements</u>, sub-section (18) be added to read as follows: (18) 400 square feet per dwelling unit required for new construction; none required

for conversion of existing building area.

SECTION III. Section 20.08.03.00, <u>Height, Bulk and Density Table</u>, BD requirements line, be amended to read as follows:

If any section, sentence or provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other parts of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid part, and to this end the provisions of this chapter are declared to be severable.

SECTION V. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
