

ORDINANCE 84-19

To Transfer Appropriations Within the General Fund (Police Budget)

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. The Controller may adjust the appropriations of the following budget, to wit:

Police Department

From: #111 Salaries & Wages \$10,000.00

To: #442 Purchase of Equipment 10,000.00

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

SYNOPSIS

This ordinance transfers appropriations within the Police General Fund budget to provide for the purchase of a BAC Verifier to replace the existing breathalyzer. This cost is to be reimbursed from the proceeds of the criminal justice facility bond issue. The transfer also provides for the purchase of a second duplicating machine and additional transcribers to enable a twenty-four-hour-a-day transcribing service.
