ORDINANCE 84-21

TO AMEND TITLE 15 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING ANGLE PARKING, LIMITED PARKING, AND ONE-WAY STREETS AND ALLEYS IN SPECIFIC LOCATIONS; TO DESIGNATE TWO NEW NO PARKING ZONES; AND TO ADD A LOADING ZONE.

WHEREAS, the Bloomington Traffic Commission has recommended changes in Title 15 of the Bloomington Municipal Code regarding parallel parking, limited and no parking zones, loading zones, and traffic flow in certain specified locations in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Bloomington Common Council is authorized by statute to make rules governing vehicle traffic and parking on public ways in the City; and

WHEREAS, various conditions regarding parallel parking, limited and no parking zones, loading zones, and traffic flow exist in the municipality which require correction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, THAT:

SECTION 1. Bloomington Municipal Code §15.32.030, Angle Parking, Schedule L, shall be revised to delete the following entry:

SECTION 7. The following entry shall be added to Bloomington Municipal Code \$15.32.100, Loading Zones, Schedule O.

> 621 North Morton, first parking space south of driveway on West side.

SECTION 8. Severability. If any section of this Ordinance or any part of any section shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity or unconstitutionality of the remaining parts.

SECTION 9. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, and approval by the Mayor.

SYNOPSIS

This Ordinance changes parking on the south side of Seventh Street from Madison to the alley from angle to parallel parking; changes 3 minute parking on the West side of Washington Street one space 100 feet south of Smith Avenue to two (2) hour parking; designates no parking areas on the south side of Hillside Drive between Walnut and Monon Streets, and on State Court Street on either side from Highland to Jordan Avenues; changes the traffic flow on Smith Avenue, formerly all one-way east, so that the first half block from Walnut to the next alley east, will be two-way and the remainder one-way west; designates traffic on the first east-west alley north of Second Street as one-way east from Walnut Street to the first alley west of Walnut; and adds a loading zone at 621 North Morton, the first parking space south of the driveway, on the west side.

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
