To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this, PUD/PCD-19-84, and recommended that the petitioner, GWEN BAKER AND PEGGY STEPHENS WATSON, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and requests that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RE to RS and from RE to BL for property located at the east side of Smith Road south of East Third Street.

Parcel to be rezoned from RE to RS:

Part of the northwest quarter of Section 1, Township 8 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of said Section 1; thence north 0 degrees 05 minutes 50 seconds east 996.75 feet; thence south 88 degrees 40 minutes 23 seconds east 416.68 feet; thence south 0 degrees 07 minutes 29 seconds west 200.00 feet thence south 88 degrees 40 minutes 23 seconds east 1511.32 feet; thence south 0 degrees east 774.78 feet; thence north 89 degrees 19 minutes 36 seconds west 1929.16 feet to the point of beginning containing 38.6 acres more or less. Subject to all easements and right-of-ways.

Parcel to be rezoned from RE to BL:

Part of the northwest quarter of Section 1, Township 8 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of said Section 1; thence north 0 degrees 05 minutes 56 seconds east 1196.75 feet; thence south 88 degrees 40 minutes 23 seconds east 416.77 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing south 88 degrees 40 minutes 23 seconds east 1510.70 feet; thence south 0 degrees east 400.00 feet; thence north 88 degrees 40 minutes 23 seconds east 1511.32 feet; thence north 0 degrees 07 minutes 29 seconds east 400.00 feet to the point of beginning 13.88 acres more or less.

SECTION II. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline plan be approved and that the above described parcels be designated a planned commercial and planned unit development, with the division between the planned commercial and planned unit designations being the centerline of the proposed new east-west roadway.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
