

ORDINANCE 84-51

TO AMEND THE 1985 SALARY ORDINANCE TO CREATE THE POSITION OF PROGRAMMER I AND PROGRAMMER II AND TO CORRECT DATA PROCESSING MANAGER SALARY.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Pursuant to the resolution of the Utilities Service Board of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, the salary and pay schedule for the employees of the said Board from and after the 5 day of October, 1984, shall be incorporated into SECTION I and SECTION II of ORDINANCE 84-38 as follows:
