SYNOPSIS

The Planning Department is requesting that a Planning Technician position be added to the 1984 Salary Ordinance at a wage of \$6.42/hour.There is a need for a new planner to help reduce the workload of the currently overburdened planning staff, and to enhance the staff's capability to recover revenues from federally-funded transportation planning programs. The new person will work about halftime on eligible transportation planning activities, and half-time on the paperworkintensive activities of zoning and development. The Planning Department intends to use the new staff person in such a way as to ensure that the salary would also be fully recovered through additional revenues from the federal transportation planning grants.
