RE: Street Located Between College and Walnut (Donald Baugh)

ORDINANCE 84 - 65

WHEREAS, IC 36-7-3-12 authorizes the Common Council to vacate public ways and places upon petition of persons who own or are interested in lots contiguous to those public ways and places; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner, Donald Baugh, has filed a petition to vacate a parcel of City property, Thirteenth Street between College and Walnut Streets.

WHEREAS, IC 36-7-3-512 requires the Plan Commission to make a recommendation on the proposed vacation and to forward it to the Common Council; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this petition and made a favorable recommendation on its adoption;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-3-12, a portion of City-owned property on Thirteenth Street between College and Walnut shall be vacated. The property is more particularly described as follows:

So much of Thirteenth Street in Kenwood Addition that lies between North College Avenue and North Walnut Street, as shown by the plat recorded in plat Book 2, page 21 in the Office of the Recorder of Monroe County. Thirteenth Street is fifty feet in width.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council, approval by the Mayor, and published according to law.
