To Request the Planning Commission to amend the Zoning Ordinance Re: New Residential Construction in the BD Zone


WHEREAS, I.C. 36-7-4-611 and I.C. 36-7-4-511 provide that the legislative body may direct the advisory plan commission to prepare an amendment to the zoning ordinance and submit it to public hearing within sixty (60) days after formal written request by the legislative body; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council wishes the Plan Commission to consider an amendment to the zoning ordinance relaxing standards for new residential construction in the BD zone in the City;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, that:

The Plan Commission prepare an amendment to Section 20.80.030 of the Bloomington Municipal Code that would relax the zoning standards for new residential construction in the BD zone, and submit the amendment to public hearing.
