ORDINANCE 83-10

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS,

the Plan Commission has considered this case, PUD-5-83, and recommended that the petitioner, Carl Smith be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain

property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline plan be approved and the site be designated a planned unit development, for property located at 3513 Leonard Springs Rd. more particularly described as follows:

A part of the Southeast quarter of Section 13, Township 8 North, Range 2 West in Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Fifty two (52) acres off the north side of the southeast quarter of Section Thirteen (13), Township Eight (8) North Range Two (2) West of the 2nd principal meridian, bounded and described as follows, to wit: beginning at the northeast corner of said southeast quarter, running thence West on the North line of said southeast quarter One Hundred Sixty (160)rods; more or less, to the northwest corner of said southeast quarter; thence South on the West line of said southeast quarter Fifty-two (52) rods, thence East parallel with the North line of said southeast quarter One Hundred and Sixty (160) rods, more or less, to the East line of said southeast quarter; thence North on said East line Fifty-Two (52) rods, more or less, to the place of beginning.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
