

An Ordinance Concerning the Voluntary Annexation of Contiguous Territory

WHEREAS, the boundary of the City of Bloomington is contiguous to the real estate described herein, and

WHEREAS, on March 8, 1983, a Petition for Annexation of the real estate described herein was filed by the owners of said real estate, requesting annexation of the area pursuant to I.C. 36-4-3-5;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. The following described land be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

"A part of the Northeast quarter of Section 32, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point that is 1033.00 feet East and 300.00 feet South of the Northwest corner of said quarter in said Section 32; thence running East for 100.00 feet; thence North 00 degrees 38 minutes East for 73.00 feet; thence South 88 degrees 59 minutes East for 84.99 feet; thence South 00 degrees 38 minutes West for 22.00 feet; thence East for 182.50 feet and to the West right-of-way of Maple Street; thence with said right-of-way South 00 degrees 38 minutes West for 770.50 feet; thence leaving said road and running West for 267.50 feet; thence North 00 degrees 38 minutes East for 376.00 feet; thence West for 100.00 feet; thence North 00 degrees 38 minutes East for 345.00 feet and to the point of beginning. Containing in all 5.57 acres, more or less.

SECTION II. Be it further ordained that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be and the same hereby are, declared extended to include all of the real estate herein above described as part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with law.
