ORDINANCE 83 - 33

To Vacate a Public Parcel

WHEREAS, IC 36-7-3-12 authorizes the Common Council to vacate public ways and places upon petition of persons who own or are interested in lots contiguous to those public ways and places; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner, BLOOMINGTON DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, has filed a petition to vacate a parcel of City property on Buttonwood Lane; and

WHEREAS, IC-36-7-3-512 requires the Plan Commission to make a recommendation on the proposed vacation and to forward it to the Common Council; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this petition and made a favorable recommendation on its adoption;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-3-12, a portion of City-owned property on Buttonwood Lane shall be vacated. The property is more particularly described as follows:

44 feet of even width off the entire south end of Buttonwood Lane, in the plat of Spicewood II-Section Two, recorded April 5, 1977, in Plat Book 6, page 116, as Instrument #84817, in the Office of the Recorder of Monroe County, Indiana.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council, approval by the Mayor, and published according to law.
