To Vacate a Public Parcel

WHEREAS, IC-36-7-3-12 authorizes the Common Council to vacate public ways and places upon petition of persons who own or are interested in lots contiguous to those public ways and places; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner, CFC, Inc., has filed a petition to vacate a parcel of City property on the east/west alley between inlots 302 and 303; and

WHEREAS, IC 36-7-3-512 requires the Plan Commission to make a recommendation on the proposed vacation and to forward it to the Common Council; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this petition and made a favorable recommendation on its adoption;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-3-12, a portion of City-owned property on the east/west alley between inlots 302 and 303 shall be vacated. The property is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point located at the northeast corner of in-lot number 303, thence north for a distance of twelve (12) feet to the southeast corner of in-lot number 302, thence west over and along the south lot line of in-lot 302 for a distance of fifty-eight (58) feet thence south for twelve feet to a point on the north lot line of in-lot 303, thence over and along the north lot line of in-lot 303 for a distance of fifty-eight (58) feet to the northeast corner of in-lot number 303 of the original plat of Bloomington, Indiana, Monroe County, Indiana.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council, approval by the Mayor, and published according to law.
