To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978, which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-48-83, and recommended that the petitioner, City of Bloomington Plan Commission, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RE to ML for property located north of Whitehall Pike and east of Hartstrait Road, and more particularly described as follows:

The Southeast quarter of Section 35, Township 9 North, Range 2 West; and the South half of the Northeast quarter of Section 35, Township and Range aforesaid; excepting therefrom a strip of even width 53 and 1/3 rods wide off the East side of both the above described tracts of land; and also excepting 5 acres, out of the Southwest corner of said Southeast quarter, bounded as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of said Southeast quarter, running thence North along the West line of said Quarter 40 rods, thence East parallel with the South line of said Quarter 20 rods, thence South 40 rods, thence West 20 rods to the place of beginning,

Also excepting eight acres out of the northeast quarter bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point 960 feet east of the northwest corner of the south one half of the northeast quarter of section 35 thence South 26 degrees East for 500 feet; thence South 75 degrees 27 minutes East for 600 feet to the east property line of the Kennedy property; thence north 600 feet; thence west 800 feet to the point of beginning, containing in this description, after deducting said three exceptions 147 acres more or less.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
