## SYNOPSIS

This ordinance transfers appropriations within the Parks and Recreation Fund for various purposes; monies are available due to cutbacks on hiring of park maintenance summer employees. The dry hot summer reduced the need for routine grass cutting responsibilities, hence, a reduction of seasonal employment workforce.
