

RESOLUTION 83-10

TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON TO APPLY FOR STATE
OR FEDERAL ASSISTANCE FOR WASTEWATER TREATMENT PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the Wastewater Treatment and Collection System of the City of Bloomington and the regions of which it is a part is inadequate to meet the future needs of the community within the standards of the wastewater treatment regulations as required by the State of Indiana and the Environmental Protection Agency of the United States, and

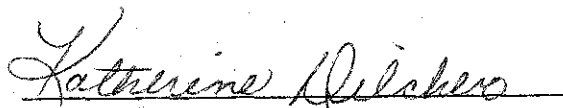
WHEREAS, State and Federal assistance is available to provide the expansion and renovation necessary to meet these standards, and

WHEREAS, on March 1, 1973, a Resolution was adopted by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington which authorized the Mayor, Francis X. McCloskey to execute and file necessary documents on behalf of the City to apply for such assistance, and to continue the effect of said Resolution, it is now necessary to provide that the incumbent Mayor, Tomilea Allison, be authorized to so apply for said assistance,

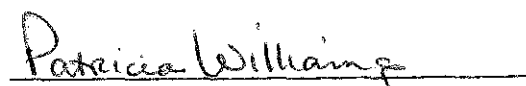
