

TO AMEND CHAPTER 15.72 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE
TO ELIMINATE PARKING METER ENFORCEMENT ON SATURDAYS

WHEREAS, the Common Council is authorized by statute to make rules governing parking on city streets;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 15.72.070, Times When Provisions Inapplicable-Generally, be amended to read as follows:

The provisions of this chapter shall not apply on Saturdays, Sundays and Legal Holidays.


SECTION II. Section 15.72.080, Times When Provisions Applicable, be amended to read as follows:

The provisions of this chapter including hourly charges shall apply to vehicles parked or standing upon the streets of the city in the congested areas herein before described between the hours of nine a.m. and five p.m. of any day except Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays.


SECTION III. If any section of this ordinance or any part of any section shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional such declaration shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.




