ORDINANCE 82-37

TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAPS, DATED JUNE 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordiance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incoporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS,

EAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, HP-16-82, and recommended that the petitoner, Mrs. Emily McConnell and Miss Mildred Johnson, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the designation of Historic be granted to property located at 105 Country Club Drive more particularly described as follows:

> A part of the West half of the Northwest quarter of Section 16, Township 8 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, described as follows. Beginning at the Northeast corner of the NOrthwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 16, Township 8 North, Range 1 West; said point being on the centerline of Country Club Road for a distance of Two Hundred (200) feet, thence South for a distance of Three Hundred (300) feet, thence East Two Hundred (200) feet to a point on the East line of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of said section line for Three Hundred (300) feet and to the point of beginning.

SECTION II. This ordianance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
