ORDINANCE 82-50

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

- WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and
- WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, HP-21-82, and recommends that the petitioners, David and Julie Cline, CFC, Inc., be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the designation of Historic be granted to property located at 316 N. Washington, more particularly described as follows:

In Lot Number Three Hundred Thirty-two (332) in the City of Bloomington, Indiana as per plat thereof, recorded in the Plat Book 1, at Page 7 of the records of the Recorder's Office of Monroe County, Indiana, and all improvements thereon.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
