ORDINANCE 82-62

To Vacate a Public Right-of-Way

WHEREAS, IC 36-7-3-12 authorizes the Common Council to vacate public ways and places upon petition of persons who own or are interested in lots contiguous to those public ways and places; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner, Real Estate Problem Solvers, has filed a petition to vacate a portion of alley right-of-way located between 14th and 15th Streets, midblock between Madison and Woodburn Avenues; and

WHEREAS, IC 36-7-4-512 requires the Plan Commission to make a recommendation on the proposed vacation and to forward it to the Common Council; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this petition and made a favorable recommendation on its adoption;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-3-12, a portion of the north-south alley shall be vacated that is located between 14th and 15th Streets, midblock between Madison and Woodburn Avenues, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Southeast corner of Lot 47 Kenwood Addition, said point being on the East line of an existing 12 foot alley right-of-way, thence North for a distance of 132 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 48, Kenwood Addition, thence East for a distance of 12 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 58, Kenwood Addition, thence South for 132 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 58, thence West for 12 feet to the point of beginning. Said alley right-of-way being located in the Kenwood Addition to the City of Bloomington, Indiana, as shown by the recorded plat thereof.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council, approval by the Mayor, and published according to law.
