ORDINANCE 82- 63

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-28-82 , and recommended that the petitioner, KEnneth Stuart be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from BA (Business Arterial) to ML (Manufacturing Light) for property located at 5228 N. SR 37 more particularly described as follows:

A part of the north half of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of section eight, township nine north, range one west, Monroe County Indiana. More specifically described as follows: beginning at a point 245' west of the center of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 8, thence north 600', thence east 367' to the right-of-way of old State Road 37, thence south 12 degrees 0 minutes east along right-of-way 607' thence west 423' to the point of beginning. Containing $5\frac{1}{2}$ acres more or less.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
