

ORDINANCE 82-75

TO TRANSFER APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND, THE PARKS AND RECREATION FUND, AND THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING FUND OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. The City Controller may adjust the appropriations of the following budgets:



SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.





SYNOPSIS

This ordinance approves budget transfers within the general funds. General Fund transfers are needed in the Fire Department budget to cover the final cost of installation of a new generator and in the Police Department budget for the purchase of portable radios and telephone dictating equipment. A transfer is needed in the Parks and Recreation Fund for year-end routine operating expenses and in the Parks and Recreation /Federal Revenue Sharing Fund budget to complete the installation of the Older American Center elevator.
