

RESOLUTION 82-5


TO REQUEST THE ADMINISTRATION TO PROVIDE ANNUAL REPORTS  
ON THE PROGRESS BEING MADE IN MEETING THE CITY'S  
AFFIRMATIVE ACTION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Affirmative Action Advisory Board was created in 1975 to develop goals and timetables for the city's work force as part of an affirmative action plan, and in 1979 made recommendations to the Mayor which were subsequently adopted as the city's hiring goals; and

WHEREAS, the Sunset Review Committee of the Common Council reviewed the Board and found that it has fulfilled its purpose and may therefore be terminated, but also expressed concern that there be adequate monitoring of the city's progress in meeting its goals and timetables;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:


Upon recommendation of the Sunset Review Committee, the Common Council requests that the administration provide annual reports on the progress being made by the city in meeting its affirmative action plan, and that such reports be made available to the Council and all interested city employees.

SYNOPSIS

The Sunset Review Committee has recommended that the Affirmative Action Advisory Board be terminated since it has performed its function of establishing goals and timetables, but that there should be some monitoring of the city's progress in meeting its affirmative action plan. This resolution requests annual reports from the administration to keep the Council and interested city employees informed of the city's progress in this area.
