

RESOLUTION 82-19

To Designate the Princess Theater Property on North Walnut Street as an Urban Development Area

WHEREAS, Thomas D. Canada, has filed an application for designation of the old Princess Theater property as an "Urban Development Area"; and

WHEREAS, The Application has been reviewed by the Departments of Redevelopment and Planning, and the Redevelopment Commission has passed a Resolution recommending to the Common Council the approval of the "Urban Development Area" designation for said property; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has investigated the area described in detail in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof; and


WHEREAS, the area described above has become undesirable for normal development and occupancy due to the deterioration of improvements, age, obsolescence, and substandard building conditions, and the project as proposed will be of public utility and benefit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:


1. The Common Council finds and determines that the area described above is an Urban Development Area as set forth in Indiana Code 6-1.1-12.1-1 et. seq.

2. As agreed to by Thomas D. Canada in his application, if the improvements described in the application are not commenced (Defined as obtaining a building permit and actual start of construction) within twelve (12) months of the date of the designation of the above area as an Urban Development Area, this Common Council shall have the right to void such designation.


