APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 82-1

To Specially Appropriate From the Depreciation Fund of the Water Utility Expenditures Not Otherwise Appropriated of the City of Bloomington Utilities

SYNOPSIS

This ordinance appropriates funds from the Water Utility's reserve funds to pay for relocating a water line along Third Street as part of the new underpass project. Because the Utilities Department had not anticipated it would have to pay this expense, it did not include it in its budget requests for either 1981 or 1982.
