To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from <u>SM-Special Medical to BL-limited business</u> for property located at <u>420 West Second Street</u> more particularly described as: _ _ _ _

Part of Seminary Lot Thirty-six (36) in the City of Bloomington, Indiana, bounded as follows: Beginning at a point on the South line of said Seminary Lot Thirty-six (36), Two Hundred Seventy-five (275) feet West of the South-east corner thereof, running thence West Seventy (70) feet; thence North One Hundred Eighteen and one-third (118 1/3) feet; thence East Seventy (70) feet; thence South One Hundred Eighteen and One-third (118 1/3) feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
