

ORDINANCE 81-8

Annexation of Adjacent and Contiguous Territory
(Woodbridge Apartments)

WHEREAS, the boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is adjacent to the real estate described herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. The following described land be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

Part of the North Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, township 9 North, Range 1 West, in Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Railroad Spike marking the Northeast Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, Township 9 North, Range 1 West; thence South $00^{\circ}36'53''$ East, along the East line of said Southwest Quarter, a distance of $1083\pm$ feet to the south Right-of-Way line of the Illinois Central Railroad; thence North $77^{\circ}06'42''$ West, along said south Right-of-Way line, a distance of 637.82 feet; thence North $00^{\circ}36'53''$ West, parallel with the East line of said Southwest Quarter, a distance of $942.21\pm$ feet to the North line of said Southwest Quarter; thence North $89^{\circ}56'57''$ East, along said North line, a distance of 620.23 feet to the point of beginning; containing 13.00 acres \pm , subject to legal highways and easements of record.



SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.


