

ORDINANCE 81-19

To Amend Section 15.76.010(1) of the Bloomington
Municipal Code, entitled "Stop Intersections, Generally",
and Section 15.76.010(2) entitled "Four-way Stop Intersections"

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,
MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 15.76.010(2) of the Bloomington Municipal Code,
entitled "Four-way Stop Intersections", shall be amended to add the following:

Montclair Avenue and Queens Way

SECTION II. Section 15.76.010(1) of the Bloomington Municipal Code,
entitled "Stop Intersections, Generally", shall be amended to delete the
following:

Montclair at Queens Way northbound and southbound


SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and



SYNOPSIS

This ordinance was submitted by the Traffic Commission so that Queens
Way traffic would stop for Montclair Avenue, but after protests from several
neighbors the Council amended the ordinance to designate the intersection as
a four-way stop.
