To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS,

the Cormon Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-3-81, and recommended that the petitioner, JAMES E. AND PATRICIA A. BURKS, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Cormon Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RS to RH for property located at 1614 and 1620 Arlington Road, more particularly described as follows:

A part of lot 2 and lot 3 in block 1 of Arlington Place Addition to the City of Bloomington, Indiana, being a subdivision of the southwest quarter of Section 29, Township 9 north. Range 1 west in Monroe County, Bounded and Described as follows, to-wit:

Eeginning at the northwest corner of lot #3, running thence east over and along the north line of said Lot 3 for a distance of 125 feet and to the real point of beginning, thence continuing east for 75 feet, running thence south for a distance of 97 feet, thence running 70 degrees west for a distance of 62 feet, and to a point which is Two (2) feet south of the Southeast corner of the Real Estate now owned by Mary Kirkman, thence running South Eighty-seven (87) degrees west for a distance of One Hundred Twenty-five and Fifteen Hundredths (125.15) feet, thence running north Twenty-one (21) degrees Twelve (12) minutes Vest for a distance of Four (4) feet, and to the southwest corner of the property now owned by Mary Kirkman thence running East along the South property line of said Mary Kirkman, for a distance of One Hundred Twenty-five (125) feet, thence running

for a distance of One Hundred Twenty-five (125) feet, thence running in a northerly direction along the East property line of Mary Kirkman and Doll Stalcup for a distance of One Hundred Fourteen (114) feet and to the place of beginning.

Also, the Northwest corner of Lot Number Three (3) in Block One (1), Arlington Place, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Northwest corner of Lot Number Three (3) in Block One (1), Arlington Place, thence East One Hundred Twenty-five (125) feet, thence South Fifty-seven (57) feet, thence West One Hundred Twenty-five (125) feet, thence North Fifty-seven (57) feet to the place of beginning.

Also, a part of Lot Three (3) in Block Number One (1) in Arlington Place Addition to the City of Bloomington, Indiana, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point or the west line of Lot Three (3), Fifty-seven (57) feet south of the northwest corner of said lot, running thence east One Hundred Twenty-five (125) feet, thence South Fifty-seven (57) feet, thence west One Hundred Twenty-five (125) feet, thence north Fifty-seven (57) feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
