## To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-1-80 , and recommended that the petitioner, LARRY BAKER , be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be rom RE/SC to RS/SC changed from for property located at South Leonard Springs Boad

A part of the Southeast quarter of Section 13, Township 8 North, Bange 2 West, in Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows: 52 acres off the North side of the Southeast quarter of Section 13, Township 8 North, Eange 2 West of the 2nd Principal Manidian bounded and described as follows to with Description at Meridian, bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Southeast quarter, running thence West on the North line of said Southeast quarter 160 rods, more or less, to the Northwest corner of said Southeast quarter, thence South on the West line of said Southeast quarter 52 rods, thence East parallel with the North line of said Southeast quarter, thence North on said East line 52 rods, more or less to the place of beginning.
