To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, PUD-12-81, and recommended that the petitioner, DONALD R. MITCHELL, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington Zoning Maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of loomington, Monroe County, Indiana, that:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline plan be approved and the site be designated a planned unit development, for property located on East 10th Street east of John Hinkle Place, more particularly described as follows:

A part of the northeast quarter and a part of the southeast quarter of section 35, township 9 North, Range 1 West, described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of the southeast quarter of said section 35; and in the center line of State Highway #45; thence running north 89 degrees east over and along the center line of said Highway for a distance of 171.5 feet; thence running north 84 degrees east and continuing over the center line of said highway for a distance of 75.75 feet; thence running north 75 degrees 30 minutes east and still over and along the center line of State Highway #45 for a distance of 130 feet; thence running south for a distance of 1110 feet more or less and to the north right of way line of the I.C.R.R. right of way; thence running north 78 degrees 30 minutes west over and along the north right of way line of the I.C.R.R. for a distance of 385 feet; thence running north for a distance of 992 feet and to the place of beginning. Containing in all 8.95 acres, more or less.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
