POLICE PENSION FUND


From: #53 Refunds, Awards and Indemnities \$ 10.00

#44 Other Materials 200.00


SECTION II. THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.


