ORDINANCE 81-54

To Amend Section 20.09.04.01 of the Bloomington Municipal Code to Increase the Membership of the Historic District and Buildings Study Committee

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOM-INGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 20.09.04.01 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled "Membership appointment", shall be amended to read as follows:

20.09.04.01 Membership appointment. The members of the study committee shall consist of seven persons, four of whom shall be appointed by the mayor, and three of whom shall be appointed by the council. When possible, one member of the study committee shall be an architect or other technically qualified person to be appointed by the mayor. The members of the study committee shall be residents of the planning jurisdiction of the city of Bloomington.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
