

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, HP-28-81, and recommended that the petitioner, B & C CONSTRUCTION, INC. be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be amended to designate "Historic" property located at 322 West 2nd Street more particularly described as follows:

A part of Seminary Lot Number 15 in the City of Bloomington, Indiana, being a part of Section 5, Township 8 North, Range 1 West, bounded and described as follows, to-wit; Beginning at the southwest corner of said Seminary Lot Number 15, running thence East for 44 feet, thence north for 102.85 feet, thence West for 44 feet, thence south for 102.85 feet along the west line of said lot to the place of beginning.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
