## To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, RS/PUD-38-81, and recommended that the petitioner, Richard Lee Hartung be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RE (Residential Estate) to RS (Single Dwelling Residential) for property located at the north end of Northwoods Lane more particularly described as follows:

Part of the East half of the Northeast quarter of Section Seventeen (17), Township Nine (9) North, Range One (1) West, in Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning on the West line of the said half quarter section, One Thousand Sixty and Eleven hundredths (1060.11) feet South Zero (00) degrees Zero (00) minutes Six (06) seconds West from the Northwest corner of the said half quarter section; thence South Zero (00) degrees Zero (00) minutes Six (06) seconds West along the West line of the said half quarter section One Thousand Five Hundred Nineteen and One hundredths (1519.01) feet to a point Seventy-five (75) feet North from the Southwest corner of the said half quarter section; thence South Sixty-seven (67) degrees Twenty-eight (28) minutes Tifty-two (52) seconds East Two Hundred and Twenty-six hundredths (200.26) feet to the South line of the said half quarter section at a point One Hundred Eighty-five (185.00) feet East from the Southwest corner of the said half quarter section; thence South Eighty-nine (89) degrees Twenty-eight (28) minutes Twenty-nine (29) seconds East along the South line of the said half quarter section Three Hundred Ten and Ninety-seven hundredths (310.97) feet to the Southwest corner of a Thirty-two and Eighty hundredths (32.80) acre tract conveyed to "THE TRUSTEES OF INDIANA UNIVERSITY"; thence Along the West line of said Thirty-two and Eighty hundredths (32.80) acre tract North Two (02) degrees Fifty-eight (58) minutes Thirty-six (36) seconds West One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-one and Sixty-nine hundredths (1251.69) feet; thence along the Westerly line of the said Thirty-two and Eighty hundredths (32.80) acre tract North Two (01) minutes Fourteen (14) seconds West Five Bundred Fifty-four and Thirty hundredths (54.30) feet to the place of beginning, containing Fourteen and Eight hundred Thirty-eight thousandths (14.838) acres, more or

EXCEPTING THEREFROM Lots number One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Eighteen (18), Nineteen (19), Twenty (20) and Twenty-one (21) in NORTHWOODS FIRST ADDITION, being a part of the East half of the Northeast quarter of Section Seventeen (17), Township Nine (9) North, Range One (1) West in Monroe County, Indiana, as shown by the plat thereof recorded in Plat Book No. 5 at pages 97-97A in the office of the Recorder of Monroe County, Indiana.

SECTION II. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline plan be approved in the alternative and that the above designated property be designated a Planned Unit Development.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
