

ORDINANCE 81-71

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND AND MOTOR VEHICLE HIGHWAY FUND OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA.

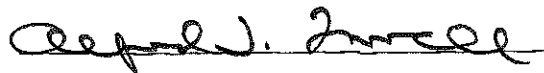

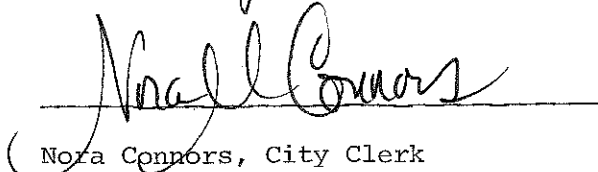
SECTION II. THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.

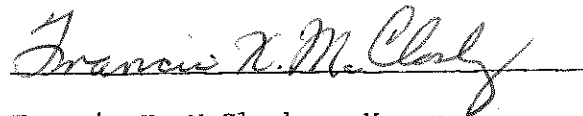
