

To: #72 Equipment \$20,500.00


SECTION II. THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.



SYNOPSIS

The Redevelopment Department has paid the Director's salary from CDBG funds this year rather than from the General Fund in order to save up appropriated funds for a transfer to complete the parking garage.
