

ORDINANCE 81-82

To Amend the Bloomington Municipal Code to Set Fees for  
Police Department's Furnishing Traffic Accident Reports

WHEREAS, IC 9-3-1-3 authorizes the Common Council to set the amount the Police Department shall charge for furnishing traffic accident reports at not less than \$3.00 per report;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 15.28.145 entitled "Accident reports-- Fees for duplicating" shall be added to read as follows:


15.28.145 Accident reports--Fees for duplicating. The traffic division is authorized to charge a fee of three dollars (\$3.00) for copies of accident reports not exceeding six pages and a fee of fifty cents (\$.50) per page for copies exceeding six pages.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.



SYNOPSIS

Effective September 1, 1981, the minimum fee the Police Department can collect for a traffic accident report went from \$2 to \$3, and city councils are now required to set the fee by ordinance. This ordinance sets the fee at \$3.00 for reports up to six pages and 50¢ per page for reports over six pages.
